Samuel Jenks, which covers the same period as the diary of Sergeant David Holden, already printed by the Society. Samuel Jenks was born in Lynn, Mass., March 12, 1732. He learned his trade (that of a blacksmith) from his father, and wrought at it successively in Chelsea (on Point Shirley), - where the journal following shows that he was residing in 1760, when he started on the campaign which it records, and in Medford, Newton, - where his son William (H. C. 1797, and member of our Society for many years) was born, - and in Boston. In the Boston Directory of 1789, the first published, his name appears, - Jenks, Samuel and Son, blacksmiths and bellows makers, at the sign of the bellows, Gardner s Wharf, Ann Street ;...
